Lodging and Price Information for SITD 2017 Registration

OVERNIGHT CONFERENCE ACCOMMODATIONS

Most of the SITD registrants will be staying in <u>Engstrom Hall</u> on the East Campus. The rooms in Engstrom are two bedrooms with two beds each that share a common bath. There are a limited number of MODS, cottages with two bedrooms in each and a shared bathroom.

Engstrom description from the APU website:

Engstrom Hall is a four-story, co-ed residence hall for freshmen. Rooms in Engstrom Hall are arranged in small suites with two rooms sharing a bathroom. Rooms include desks, twin beds, mini-blinds, and walk-in closets with shelves. Four to five students share the suite. Each floor offers a lounge, oven, vending machines, and card-operated laundry facilities. Also included are two elevators. Residents are required to purchase a dining plan in accordance with university requirements.

From our Contract:

An optional linen package includes 1 pillow, 1 pillowcase, 2 flat sheets, 1 blanket, 1 washcloth, 1 hand towel, 1 bath towel and shower soap. Please be advised that no other amenities are provided either in the rooms or in bathrooms. Guests must provide their own toiletries, alarm clocks, irons, hangers, reading lights, etc. Hot plates and appliances are not permitted. Residence halls will be assigned according to availability and size of the group. Each conference guest will be assigned a single bed. We will attempt to accommodate all requests but reserve the right to book as best suits the university.

The various accommodations are as follows:

LODGING (These prices already include a required 10% state sales tax.)

Lodging prices are per person per night price. Guests may be assigned to one or two bedrooms depending on availability and lodging area that are assigned to you by Conference Services. Summer Institute Local Planning team members at Fuller will assign your rooms based on a master list of options given to us by APU Conference Services. Laundry rooms are available; please inquire with Conference Services for specifics on using the facilities.

You will sign up for the housing you want through conference registration. Our Local Arrangements team then has a master list of the rooms and will make assignments according to your choices.

Accessible Rooms:

There are three suites in Engstrom with fully accessible bathrooms, one MODs that is accessible but with a bathtub, and accessible rooms with an accessible bathroom but the bathrooms are classical hall-shared single sex bathrooms used by multiple people.

We have put a hold on accessible rooms with fully accessible baths in two hotels: The Holiday Inn and Fairfield Inn in West Covina.
