Scholarships

The scholarships will be our standard \$250 credit towards registration costs, primarily for students but some available for people with disabilities. We cannot assist with travel or lodging. And the number of scholarships will depend on sponsorship grants and contributions. Some other options include:

Some of them have funds to help people with disabilities and family members to attend out of state conferences. Call and ask. They will tell you if there is an online process for applying. If not available, we can probably help you as well.

Lodging

This year our lodging is in hotels close to Edenton Street United Methodist Church. All of the conference sessions will take place in the church with the exception of any optional excursions. There is a range of hotels with whom we have a block of reserved rooms until @May 10, when all unreserved rooms in the block will be open to other guests. The closest hotel to Edenton Street United Methodist Church is the Holiday Inn, caddy cornered across the street. See the R-Line Map on the Summer Institute 2018 website to see the locations of three of the hotels. Note the Summer Institute and Edenton St. Church are indicated on the map. The Days Inn and Hampton Inn are within walking distance.
